This College, as well as all New Jersey county colleges, receives state funding for their own resident students in accordance with <u>NJSA 18A:64-A et seq</u>. This law allows out-of-county residents to attend this College at the in-county tuition rate if the student enrolls in an eligible program of study or particular course which is not offered at the home county college.

A student who lives in a New Jersey county, other than Gloucester or Cumberland, whose home county college does not offer the desired program of study or particular course may be eligible for chargeback benefits.
